User Registration



- •Please bring documentation that enables the library staff to confirm your address, name, and birth date, such as your insurance certificate, driver's license, or student card. If you commute to the City for work or study, you are registered as a City resident, and you can receive the same services as City residents when you bring documentation that proves that you commute to the City for work or study.
- •Library user card can be used at all City libraries in the City.
- The card can be displayed on the screen of your smartphone.
- The registration expires after 2 years. You will be required to submit the same kind of documentation as the registration to renew it.

- As a part of services for handicapped people to use libraries, services for those who find it difficult to come to a library due to a mental or physical disability to receive materials via delivery or postal services are available. In addition, in-person reading services and movie day services in a barrier-free room are also available.


Borrowing and Returns

Borrowing items

Bring items and your library user card to the counter.

Loan allowances and period

****** The allowance in the [] is applied for non-citizen registrants (living, working, or studying in the City)



Audiobooks

No limit in the loan allowance or period

E-books and audiobooks are available only for citizen registrants (living, working, or studying in the City).

• If the renewal is applied within the loan period, it will only be accepted one time. (Except items requested by another user and items owned by another City)

The renewal period is 2 weeks (or 1 week) from the applied day.

Returning items

You can return the items to any of the City libraries except items owned by another City and large picture books.

Books and Magazines


Please return at the counter or to the bookpost. (No bookpost is available at the Sengoku Library, the Library Service Counter, and the Service counter)

• The bookposts are available on the 1st floor of the Bunkyo Civic Center (1-16-21 Kasuga) and TRC Library Service Inc. Headquarters, 1st floor (3-1-1 Otsuka). The returning process may take a longer time if returned through these bookposts.

At the counter for other items

•CDs, cassette tapes, record, DVDs, videos, kamishibai, books and magazines with a CD-ROM attached, packaged items such as comics, and items borrowed from a library of another City should be returned to the counter directly.

Searching and Reserving Items



Others

•Only citizen registrants (living, working, or studying in the City) may reserve new arrival items, which are newly accepted items within one month.

The official website of the library provides opening days and hours of the libraries and announcements. You can also check your usage status, search and reserve items.






Searching	
Q	Easy book search You can search items with a title, author, keywords, etc.
Q	Advanced search You can also search with multiple search criteria or do a filter search according to the availability of the item or the libraries that store it.

	Checking usage status You can check loan status or reservation status. You can also check the due date, renew the loan period, cancel the reservation, or change the library to receive the reserved item. (However, if the reserved item is already ready at a library, receiving Library cannot be changed)
\bowtie	Register or update your contact information You can register or update your phone number and email address.
	Setting a new password/Changing the password You can set and change your login password.
	Book list and Reading record You can make book lists that you would like to read later by group. If you'd like, you can keep a record of items you have borrowed.



Announcements and Reminders

Please return the items before the due date



If you miss the due date by one week or more, you will not be able to borrow or reserve a new item unless you return all of the overdue items. If you miss the due date by one month or more, all of your reservations will be canceled.

Handle items with care when using them



•The items are for communal use. If you lose or damage an item (including if it gets wet due to rain), you will be liable for reimbursement.

•If your player malfunctions when playing an item borrowed from the library such as a CD, the library will not be liable for any responsibility.

Please refrain from eating or drinking in the library, entering into the library under the influence of alcohol, using seats for sleeping, carrying in a pet or large luggage, using a cell phone, damaging items in the library, or bothering other people.

Closed days

- If a national holiday falls on a scheduled closed day, the libraries open on the day (Nezu Library closes at 5 p.m.) and closes on the following day instead.
- The New Year's holidays are from December 30 to January 4. (From December 29 to January 4 with Nezu Library and Library Service Counter)
- The special organizing days vary according to each library.
